

## Chest Measurement

Wrap the tape around the back and chest

Important to have the officer drop arm to the side when tape is in place

If you are between inches (such as 41.5") round up to 42"



## Waist Measurement

Wrap the tape around the widest part of the waist

Important to have the officer drop arm to the side when tape is in place

If you are between inches (such as 41.5") round up to 42"

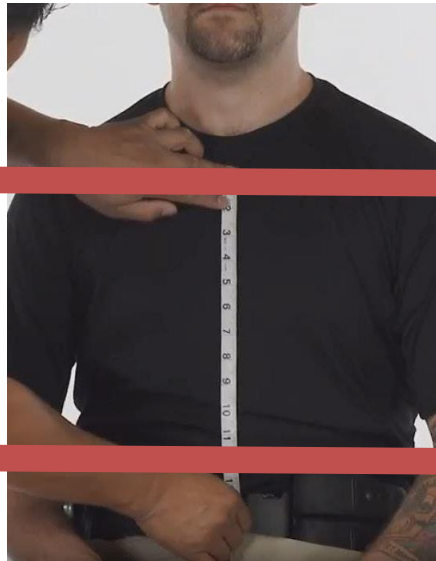


## Front Length Standing Measurement

Locate the notch in the chest bone

Place tape measure 1" below the notch

Let the tape measure drop to the top of the duty belt

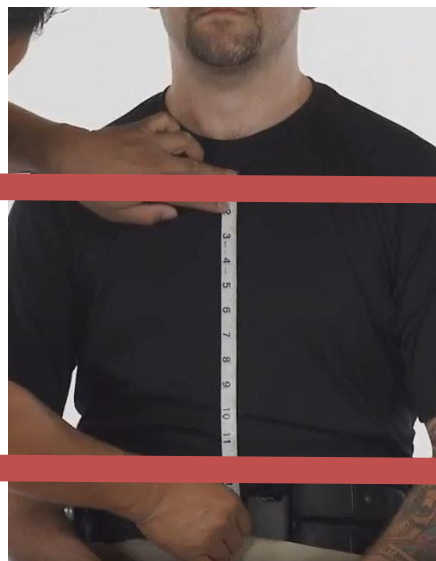


## Front Length Sitting Measurement

Locate the notch in the chest bone

Place tape measure 1" below the notch

Let the tape measure drop to the top of the duty belt



## **Front length standing if belt worn on an angle.**

Locate the notch in the chest bone

Place tape measure 1" below the notch

Can not take the measurement to the top of the duty belt.

Front measurement will be to the hip line.

## Back Length Measurement

Measure from the top of the shoulder blade to the top of the duty belt.  
Round down if between inches to ensure the panel will not be too long.
